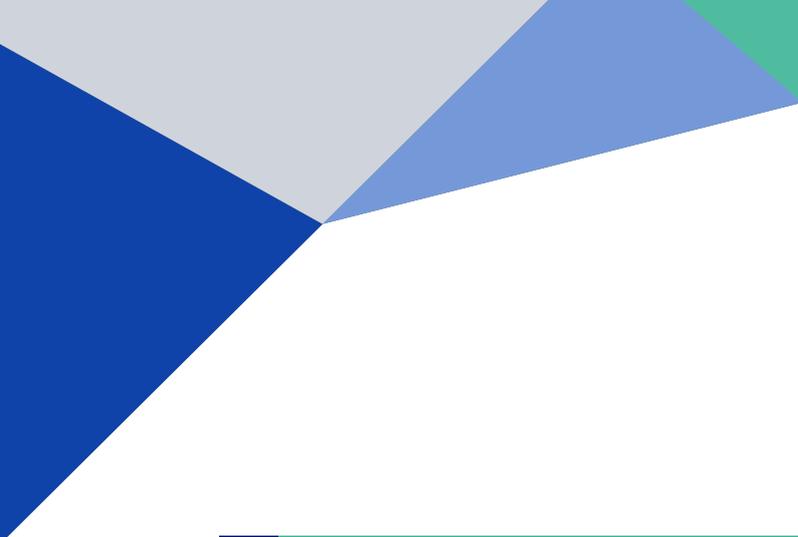

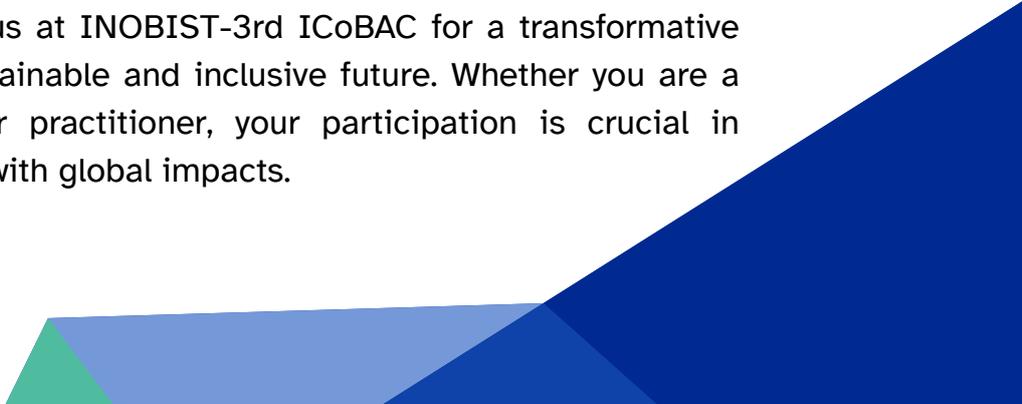
Conference Theme: "Innovating for Global Resilience: Integrating Business, Social Sciences, and Technology"

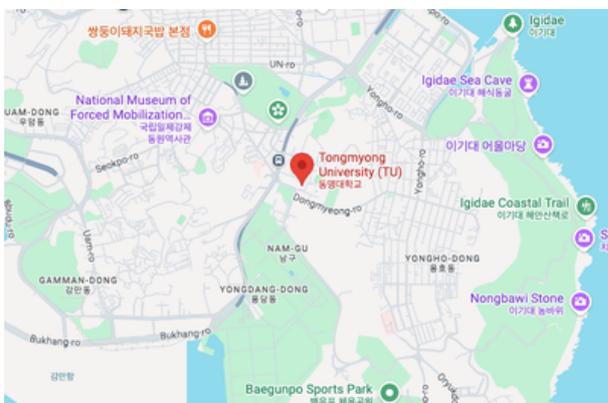

Keynote Speakers



Prof. Andriyan Bayu S., Ph.D.
School of Electrical Engineering and
Infomatics, Institut Teknologi Bandung

Andriyan Suksmono holds a Bachelor's in Physics, a Master's in Electrical Engineering from Institut Teknologi Bandung (ITB), Indonesia, and a Ph.D. in Engineering from The University of Tokyo. He worked as a Systems Programmer before joining ITB in various teaching roles, becoming a Professor in 2009. His research focuses on Quantum Computing, Signal Processing, and Imaging, earning him numerous international awards and grants. Notable achievements include the APNNA Best Paper Award in 2004 and multiple Outstanding Faculty Awards. He has developed the Quantum Hadamard matrix Search Algorithm since 2017, resulting in highly downloaded publications. Suksmono is on the Editorial Board for several journals and has led initiatives in Quantum Technology at ITB, while holding senior memberships in professional organizations.

Dieter Bögenhold is a professor at the University of Klagenfurt, Austria, with prior positions in Germany, Sweden, Italy, and Finland. He earned his degrees from Bielefeld University and specializes in business and society, inequalities, consumption, lifestyles, and economic thought history. He serves on the European Academy of Management board and chairs the VHB Committee on Science Theory and Ethics. Dieter has authored over 20 books, including "Consumption and Lifestyles" (2018, 2020), "Unheard Voices" (2019, 2021), and "Neglected Links in Economics and Society" (2022). Additionally, he has edited a section on the History of Economic Thought for a handbook and a special issue for the Atlantic Economic Journal.

Dong-Sung Cho is Professor of Strategy at Seoul National University. He received doctoral degree from Harvard Business School, and worked at Gulf Oil and Boston Consulting. He was visiting professor at HBS, Michigan, Duke, INSEAD, Helsinki, Tokyo, and Peking. He published 61 books and over 100 papers in major journals. Aalto University granted him honorary doctoral degree.

He was Dean of College of Business Administration, SNU; President of Korean Academic Society of Business Administration; and President of Korean Association of Academic Societies. He sits in the Presidential Council for National Competitiveness of Korea. He is Honorary Consul of Finland in Korea, President of Supporting Committee for the International Vaccine Institute, Director General of the Ahn Jung Geun Memorial & Museum, Director of the Korea National Opera, and Director of the Korea Professional Football League.
